

Every family is required to participate in school fundraising, with a minimum contribution of \$400 for one student or \$500 for two or more students. If this commitment is not met throughout the year, the balance will be automatically added to their FACTS account in two equal installments: November and March 2026.

Financial aid is available for students in kindergarten through 8th grade. **Note: *All families receiving financial aid must complete at least five volunteer hours for every \$500 awarded.** St. Walter-St. Benedict School provides financial assistance through PHOENIX Scholarships, Big Shoulders Fund, and STWSTB Local Scholarships for eligible families, based on the information submitted through the FACTS Grant & Aid application process. Financial aid will not be awarded until a completed FACTS financial assistance application is on file.
